27 apply for two new posts

Twenty-seven candidates have applied for the two new positions of assistant commissioner for transport created under the regionalisation scheme of the Transport Department.

The two new senior transport officers, in addition to the present three assistant commissioners, will head regional headquarters to be set up later this year.

Under the scheme, each region — the Island, Kowloon and the New Territories — will each have an assistant commissioner for transport to take care of routine or minor traffic management problems which do not have to be referred to the central headquarters.
