Details of Monday's action are expected to be finalised in the next couple of days and a final decision will be taken on Friday.

Proposed action includes refusal to accept any extra work or overtime work. The technicians are also expected to insist that they be accompanied by professional supervisors while doing outdoor work.

Mr ` said members felt strongly about the Government's refusal to consult the association on either the setting up of the commission of inquiry or

either the setting or commission of inquiry or the new pay structure.

He also said his members were further deprived of a post allowance which was granted to surveying the new granted to surveying assistants under the new pay structure.

The surveying assistants re given this post to wance, which is were given this post allowance, which is equivalent to one increment point, as they are required to work outdoors without professional supervision.

Mr Chu accused the Government of pushing the technical grade review through the Finance Committee and the Executive Council without sufficient consultations with his association.
