110 apply for judiciary job

More than 100 applications have been submitted for the post of judiciary administrator, a spokesman for the Judiciary said yesterday.

A total 110 applications had been received by the deadline on Sunday.

More were expected to arrive early this week with applications posted on Sunday being accepted.

The incumbent officer, Alice Tai Yuen-ying, is to become the ombudsman in April. The administrator's post carries a monthly salary of \$181,050.
