ABOUT 2,000 squatters are living on slopes vulnerable to landslides, a government engineer responsible for an Chief geotechnical engineer Mr Allan Watkins said the squatters would have to be rehoused before the Office could start work to stabilise the slopes.

The squatter huts are scattered in areas such as Kwai Chung, Tsing Yi and Tsuen Wan, he said.
