## 1,000 to oversee festivities

THE 1,000-member joint committee on the celebrations for the handover next year is expected to be formed in two months.

Convenor of the Preparatory Committee's handover celebration panel, Rita Fan Hsu Lai-tai, said yesterday that the panel already had several hundred organisations in hand.

At yesterday's panel meeting, members decided to write to the Urban and Regional Councils about applications for various public venues to hold handover ceremonies in late June and early July next year.

"We passed about 30 to 40 applications to the two councils in mid-June and so far we
