## 6 retain panel seats

THERE is no change in the line-up of employee representatives in the Labour Advisory Board this year.

The governor's appointment of LAB members, comprising six employers' representatives and the same number from the employees side, will be gazetted today.

Three of the employee representatives were re-elected for nomination by trade unions at the end of last year.

They are Szeto Wah, president of the Hongkong Professional Teachers' Union; Wong Wai-hung, chairman of the association of Government Land and Engineering Surveying Officers; and Poon Chi-ching, vice-chairman of the Hongkong and Kowloon Lithographic Workers' Union, which is attached to the left-wing Federation of Trade Unions.

The other three are Chan Kam-chuen, member of Cable and Wireless,

Hongkong Non-Expatriate Staff Association; Pang Chun-hoi, chairman of Cotton Industry Workers' General Union; and Lee Shing-chu, member of Hongkong Stevedores Union.

Both Mr Pang and Mr Lee's unions are affiliated to the right-wing Trade Union Council.

The six unionists had served on the board which advised the government on labour matters, last year.
