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2 more AA men quit

TWO more Automobile Association staff members yesterday resigned in support of 13 colleagues who tendered their resignations earlier in the week.

Another employee, who was the group's spokesman, was sacked last Monday.

The two employees who quit yesterday were from the shipping division of the association, dealing in the shipment of vehicles overseas.

The trouble arose out of the 16 employees' dissatisfaction over the appointment of a colleague as deputy manager.

They claimed the newly-appointed man was unqualified for the job.

The employees also accused the management of reneging on earlier promises that the appointment would not take place until the two sides met to discuss it.
