Advice for the ICAC

The Independent Commission Against Corruption should send staff to every fire to prevent possible graft, according to the Rev Sze Ying-yu.

In a speech about the ICAC at the City Hall on Sunday the Rev Sze said that although the Director of Fire Services, Mr Fred Watson, said a few days ago there was no substantive evidence to prove that some

firemen refused to extinguish fires until they were paid, the presence of an ICAC officer was the best way to probe such a strong allegation.

The Rev Sze said corruption could not be solved only by an iron fist.

"Instead, it could be totally probed by educating the people about the shame of corruption," he added.
