Bar facing prosecution

AT least one Lan Kwai Fong bar is facing prosecution for selling alcohol to two teenagers during the New Year holidays.

A senior police source said yesterday two expatriate teenagers were discovered drinking alcohol in the bar and were subsequently removed.

A successful prosecution could cost the bar owner up to \$5,000 in fines and six months in jail.

The bar, not named by police, was charged with breach of its liquor licence conditions.
