

8 English books on HK translated into Chinese ²⁴⁻¹¹

EIGHT English books about Hongkong's economy and politics have been translated into Chinese and published in China.

The Shanghai Translation Publishing Company published a number of books styled as *The Series on Hongkong Problems* during the past two years in the wake of increasing interest on the study of Hongkong in many parts of China.

These books are: Dr

Norman J Miners' *China and Hongkong's Future* and *The Government and Politics of Hongkong*; Dr Miron Mushkat's *The Making of the Hongkong Administrative Class*; Mr Valerie Ann Penlington's *Law in Hongkong*; and *Industrial Relations and Law in Hongkong* by Mr Joe England and Mr John Rear.

Also included are Dr Y C Yao's *Banking and Currency in Hongkong*, Prof David Leithbridge's *The*

Business Environment in Hongkong, and Mr David Flux's *Hongkong Taxation: Law and Practice*.

The preface to the publications says: "The books provide many records and information which would help research and study on Hongkong. But because of the problem regarding the standpoint of the authors, many views and ideas are wrong, especially on the status of Taiwan and Hongkong."
