

1,007 voters respond to phone survey

IN a bid to show the support each candidate can get in the latest stage of the election run-up, *The Standard* sponsored a territory-wide survey following a similar one three weeks ago.

A total of 1,007 registered voters responded to telephone interviews under this survey from 7 to 11 September.

It was intended to contact the 1,000 respondents who turned up at the previous survey, which was conducted from 13 to 19 August.

However, 376 of them were not available during the survey period.

As a result, 383 new samples were drawn from a pool of 30,000 telephone numbers.

Survey director Li Pang-kwong, Lingnan College political science lecturer, said the new samples did not affect the validity.

The samples were drawn deliberately in proportion to the voter distribution of Hongkong's nine geographical constituencies.

"In such case every voter in Hongkong has the same chance of being selected and there will be no bias towards any district or constituency," he said.
