Advisers get lecture from Jiang

HONGKONG'S official advisers to China started the second day with a 40-minute lecture from Chinese Communist Party General Secretary Mr Jiang Zemin.

Mr Jiang said Britain had considerable interests in Hongkong and that it was in Britain's interests to cooperate with China.
