42 polluters fined over one month

FORTY-TWO companies and individuals were convicted for pollution offences last month and received fines ranging from \$1,000 to \$30,000.

The higher penalties were for water pollution offences, which carry a maximum penalty of \$100,000, while the lower ones were mostly for air pollution and dumping at sea, where the maximums are \$20,000 and \$5.000 respectively.
